<p>What does this include?</p> <p>-High Quality childcare, education and provision that complies with the statutory Early Years Foundation Stage Framework (EYFS)</p> <p>This option does NOT include any of the option 1 benefits.</p> <p>Can only be taken TERM-TIME ONLY</p> <p>If parents do not feel able to contribute towards the funded hours via the contribution detailed in option 1 and would like to access their Working Family funded hours without charge, the nursery will allocate set sessions on a term-time only basis, that can be delivered at no charge. Parents will be unable to select their sessions. Parents will be required to supply all extras that the funding does not cover, including a healthy snack, drinks, nappies, wipes, nappy sacks, sun cream, wet weather clothes, sun hat as well as any additional resources required for enhanced activities. If you are a parents or carer of a 2 year old and you receive certain benefits, you may be eligible to apply for a free early education place.

These hours are accessed the term after your child turns 2 years, **at no additional charge**. Any additional hours over your funding will be charged at **£9ph**.

You will have the option of paying for additional extras such as visits, trips or extra activities that are not covered by the funding.

These hours can be taken as 15 hours term-time only or 11.5 hours all year round. Sessions are subject to availability

15/11.5 hours Universal Funding for ALL 3 & 4-year-olds

Available for ALL 3 & 4 year olds the term after they turn 3 and organised by the setting on your behalf.

These hours are accessed the term after your child turns 3 years, **at no additional charge**. Any additional hours over the 15 hours will be charged at **£8.50ph**

You will have the option of paying for additional extras such as visits, trips or extra activities that are not covered by the funding.

These hours can be taken as 15 hours term-time only or 11.5 hours all year round. Sessions are subject to availability
